Entry Limits

To allow more teams to enter the trial, each dog's entry is limited to the number of events it is qualified to enter. In other words, no 'extra' FEO runs are available on initial entry. For example, let's say a trial has a total of 8 Masters events. Every Masters dog can enter a maximum of 8 events (Masters, Advanced or Starters). A dog can still run FEO in any event they are entered in; however, they cannot enter more than 8 events.

If a team would like to have extra FEO runs, they should send an email to the trial secretary indicating which event(s). Extra FEO runs will be considered only after trial entry has closed.

Dog Measurement

For dogs under 2 years of age, a judge will provide a one-time measurement that will be used until the dog is 2 years old. A temporary measurement dog ID card will be emailed to the handler by AAC after the measurement is done. When the dog reaches 2 years of age, two official measurements with judge's signatures are required. This is done on the permanent dog ID card that was emailed to the handler when the dog ID number was assigned.

You must notify the Trial Secretary in advance if your dog requires measuring.

### Food

There is no concession on site, please be sure to bring enough food and water for you and your dogs. Fast food outlets are located within five minutes of the trial site.

## **Parking and Spectators**

Trial entries are limited by availability of parking spaces. If competitors carpool, more runs can be accepted. Also, if you are on the waitlist and can carpool with someone already entered, your likelihood of getting into the trial may be increased.

There is no on-site spectator parking; parking is reserved for competitors only. Spectators must park at UBCO and competitors will be required to drive them to/from the trial site. Please follow the instructions of the parking attendants. Sorry, no RV's or campers in the parking lot.

#### **Volunteers**

An electronic volunteer sign-up sheet will be sent out to all entrants prior to the trial. We thank all entrants for **volunteering** as trials cannot be run without your help. Please plan to volunteer multiple times each day - if you are running in 4 events, volunteer 4 times.

#### **Class Changes**

A dog that has entered a trial and subsequently earns a title shall be permitted to move up. Please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. Class Move-up Forms will be available at the trial for same-day move ups.

#### **Ribbons and Prizes**

There is self-service for Q and placement ribbons. If you have earned a Title, please notify the Trial Chair who will arrange for your ribbon(s).

* Our trial site is located in the center of a turf farm. Dogs may be walked only in designated areas, not on the turf or the road.

## Junior Handlers

Junior handlers must obtain a Junior Handler Identification Number prior to entering the trial as a

Junior Handler. Go to www.aac.ca for more information.

## **Accessibility Option (AO)**

Senior handlers (65 years and over) and handlers with disability may request a modified course time and a modified points requirement. Proof of disability or age will not be requested by the host club. A handler must indicate on the entry form (by checking the AO box) if they are requesting the AO option to receive modified times/reduced number of points.

#### Crating

Crating will be from your vehicle and a few spots in the paddock area. There will be no crating inside the barn. Club crates will not be available for use.

#### Accommodation

Please note that due to site and space restrictions there will be NO on-site camping. There are several campsites and hotels within five minutes of the site. For additional information, contact the trial secretary.

#### **Notice to Exhibitors**

Full refunds will be provided to handlers having to withdraw from the trial due to COVID-19 related illness or in the case of an injury or illness to a dog or handler or bitches in season.

If withdrawing after trial close date for reasons other than illness/injury to dog or handler, an administration fee of \$25 may be assessed if your entry cannot be filled from our waitlist. Please notify the trial secretary as soon as possible.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited to, the following:

This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations (as of January 1, 2024) and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression.

The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.

No food shall be permitted on course; this includes obstacle familiarization.

**Collars in the ring** – dog will be allowed to wear a close-fitting collar, with no attachments, in the ring.

#### For FEO runs only, toys will be permitted in the ring.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

All dogs must be kept in their ex-pen, crate, or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when leaving the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out-of-control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

## **Bitches in season:**

BIS will be allowed on site and to compete in trials, following the policies outlined below:

- Handlers of BIS are required to notify the Trial Secretary as soon as it is known.
- All competitors will be notified that there is a BIS at the trial.
- The handler of the BIS or the handler of any other dog entered may withdraw from the trial with a full refund if they choose not to compete.
- The crating and movements, including pottying, of the BIS will be limited to designated areas so that the BIS is kept isolated from other dogs at all times.
- Crating of BIS will be done in a vehicle.
- The BIS will wear well-fitted protective panties, specifically designed for the purpose of containing seasonal discharges. The panties will be removed only for pottying and, when crated. Panties must be replaced immediately following pottying. Panties will be worn when running a course.
- BIS will run at the end of the class.
- "BIS" will be noted next to the dog's name on the gate list.
- BIS may wear a red bandana (to be removed when running a course), provided by CODAC, to identify the dog as a BIS.

## **Directions to trial site:**

From the North: on Highway 97 you will pass the Kelowna International Airport and the turnoff to the University of British Columbia – Okanagan and then go over an overpass. Immediately after the overpass, turn East (left) onto Hereron Road. Turn North (left) almost immediately onto Bulman Road. You will see a sign telling you about golf courses. Turn into the first driveway on the right. It is marked with a turf farm sign and a private property sign. Drive down (note 15 km/h speed limit) to the red barn and park on the North side.

From the South/West: Travel through Kelowna towards Vernon on Highway 97 and as you are leaving the city, you will pass Edwards Rd and be approaching the exit overpass to UBCO. Turn right just before the overpass onto Hereron Road. Turn North (left) almost immediately onto Bulman Road. You will see signs telling you about golf courses. Turn into the first driveway on the right. It is marked with a turf farm sign and a private property sign. Drive down (note 15 km/h speed limit) to the red barn and park on the North side.
